



RISK FACTORS FOR THROMBOEMBOLISM (BLOOD CLOTS) INCLUDE:

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| Inherited thrombophilia (eg. Factor V Leiden) | Pre-eclampsia |
| History of superficial vein thrombosis | Unplanned cesarean section |
| Bedrest for 7 or more days during pregnancy | Small for gestational age infant |
| Pre-pregnancy BMI \geq 30 | Postpartum hemorrhage |
| Smoking prior to pregnancy | Postpartum infection |
