



RISK FACTORS FOR THROMBOEMBOLISM (BLOOD CLOTS) INCLUDE:

Inherited thrombophilia (eg. Factor V Leiden)
History of superficial vein thrombosis
Bedrest for 7 or more days during pregnancy
Pre-pregnancy BMI ≥ 30
Smoking prior to pregnancy

Pre-eclampsia
Unplanned cesarean section
Small for gestational age infant
Postpartum hemorrhage
Postpartum infection
